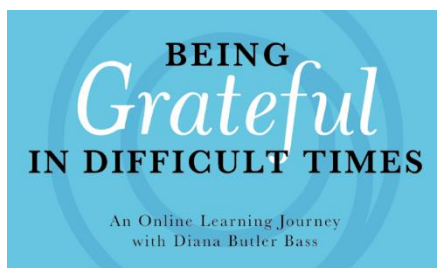

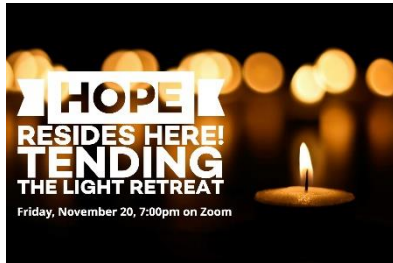

Men's Breakfast Connection on Zoom: Saturday, Nov. 21st at 8:30am Speaker: Dee Dutrochet Djoko

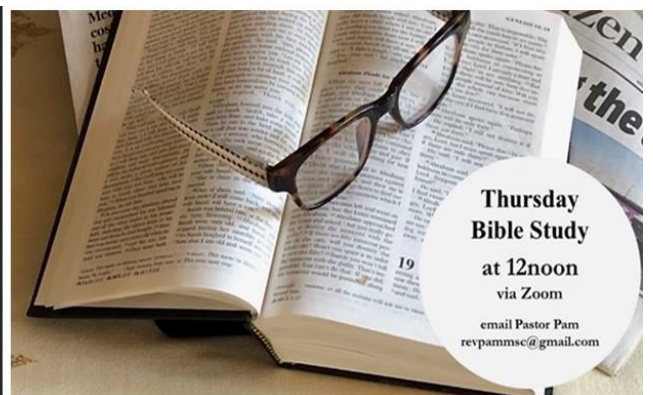
