### Agenda:

1. Affirm the actions taken at the September 27, 2020 Congregational Meeting and approve the minutes from the September 27, 2020 Congregational Meeting.
2. Receive an update on MSC's activities, operations and missions and the continued impact of the Pandemic caused by COVID-19.
3. Vote on revisions to the MSC Bylaws.
4. Receive an update from the Task Force on the Designated Term Pastors ("DTP Task Force") on its findings and activities associated with MSC's period of discernment which began in January 2019 with the goal of developing a faithful and effective pastoral leadership structure for MSC's ministries.
5. Vote on the Church Council's recommendations based upon the DTP Task Force's findings and conclusions with respect to:
  - A. MSC's pastoral leadership structure, and
  - B. Filling MSC's pastoral leadership positions.
